8.	Announcements Executive Council and Gov.Com (Art .49/50RVO IC)	Effective yesterday May 26th we have entered into Phase2 of the Roadmap for reopening our island. The Public Entity St. Eustatius will not divert from its strategy and entry policy that has kept the island COVID free since the start
		of the pandemic. A joint Press Conference is scheduled on Friday morning (May 28th) at 09.30 am. Participating in this joint press moment are the SEHCF, GGD, Chairman of the Central Committee Councilman Merkman and Deputy Government Commissioner.
		The Island Council is herewith informed that the Executive Council has appointed three civil servants to follow-up on an invitation form the Ministry of Finance to meet on a letter received from the Executive Council on April 15th regarding



		the Motion adopted by the Council on the Banking situation on the island. Two senior civil servants of the Unit Finance and a senior civil servant of the Directorate of ENI will meet with counterparts to discuss the banking situation on St. Eustatius as outlined in the motion of the Island Council.  The Joint Letter of the BES islands to the Second Chamber are in the final stages and will be ready for distribution tomorrow (Friday May 28 th). As was agreed earlier the points of the island Council of St. Eustatius will be included as an annex. The writing will take into account the common concerns as well as the island specific concerns of each island.
