Public Notice! Covid 19 Travel and Quarantine: National and Local Policies apply

On July 1st the Ministry of Infrastructure and Water Management announced a new, adjusted flight ban. Different media reported on the easing of the flight ban, but failed to mention that local admittance policies still apply, as communicated by the Public Entity St. Eustatius on July 1st.

Statia Travel and Quarantine policy per July 1st

People of the following categories are allowed to enter Statia:

- 1. Returning medical referrals
- 2. Essential workers (both for government and for companies)
- 3. Returning Statia residents
- 4. Returning Students (after ending the school year)

Other categories of persons coming from medium and high risk countries are not allowed to enter Statia. Family visits or touristic visits are allowed from low risk countries only.

All people visiting Statia need to have approval before entering Statia. To request approval, please send an email to <u>info.covid19@statiagov.com</u>

The Government of St. Maarten requires persons coming to St. Maarten to be tested before boarding the plane. Testing for Covid 19 is not an

obligatory measure for coming to Statia. Tests do not exclude contamination after the time of testing.
