QUESTIONS:

Since Jan1st 2021 the Kadaster is the responsibility of Kadaster Nederland. I therefore have the following questions.

1. Has the transfer of all files related to St. Eustatius from Stichting Kadaster St. Maarten been completed? If not, what are the bottlenecks?
2. What is the financial arrangement between OL St. Eustatius and Kadaster Nederland?
3. Have the fees been changed for the services of the Kadaster since the take over by Kadaster Nederland? And if so, can an overview be provided?
4. It appears that personnel working for Kasaster Nederland still are on the payroll and being paid by OL St. Eustatius. Who is their official employer, who do they report to and what arrangement has been put in place between OL St. Eustatius and Kadaster Nederland with regard to these personnel?
5. How has the personnel been informed about such an arrangement?
6. Who is paying the rent, operational expenses and other monthly cost of the Kadaster office?
7. The transfer of the Kadaster supposes to have consequences to the budget of the Public Entity. Has a budget amendment been carried out? If not, why not?
8. The combination of the Domain office and Kadaster has always been a point of discussion. It is noticed that still the Domain function is carried out at the Kadaster office.
 - a. How does this work in practice and who is responsible for what?
 - b. What plans have been put in place and what timeline to separate these two functions?
9. As the Kadaster is since January 1st no longer the responsibility of the Public Entity, why is it still part of the 12 criteria needed to be completed for the Island Council to move to the next phase of the "Wet herstel voorzieningen St. Eustatius"?
