QUESTIONS:

1. Has the rejection of the ordinances, "Huurcommissie- en huurprijzenverordening Sint Eustatius 2021" and "Verhuursubsidieverordening Sint Eustatius 2021" in the meeting of the Island Council of September 20th, 2021 effectively halted the process of building new social houses and renovating the existing social houses on Sint Eustatius?
2. Did this step also nullify future agreements with the Public Entity, BZK, SHF and Bazalt Wonen. Has the window of opportunity closed for receiving the needed funding or investments for the execution of the new construction and renovations?
3. What is or was the projected number of social houses to be renovated and built in 2021 and 2022?
4. Wat do the ordinances "Huurcommissie- en huurprijzenverordening Sint Eustatius 2021" and "Verhuursubsidieverordening Sint Eustatius 2021" have to do with Bazalt Wonen?
5. A direct result of the passing of these ordinances would be more financial support to The St. Eustatius Housing Foundation. Can I also conclude that rejecting these laws means less financial support to the St. Eustatius Housing Foundation?
6. Have we arrived at an impasse or are there other steps that can be taken to move the process forward?
