



## **SINT EUSTATIUS CARIBISCH NEDERLAND**

### **Protocol for vaccinated persons arriving from a very high risk country**

You are required to follow the monitoring protocol for the first five days of your stay on Sint Eustatius. You receive upon entering an appointment for a COVID-19 antigen test at the public health on the 5<sup>th</sup> day.

- Keeping social distance
  - Social distance implies keeping a distance of at least 6 feet towards other persons
  - This needs to be done both in public and private settings (also at home if there are persons you did not arrive with on the same day)
  - The only exemption for this are the persons you arrived with (colleagues, family f.e.)
  - Good social distancing implies limiting your contacts to the necessary contacts and with each contact evaluating if it is needed during the period of the monitoring protocol or also can be postponed until after the five days.
  - Good social distancing implies that you inform each close contact which you have on your status (informing them that you are under the monitoring protocol) which gives your contact the possibility to assure that he/she is also well protected
- Proper hand hygiene
  - This implies regularly washing your hands (30 seconds) thoroughly and after each contact you had
  - If you are not able to wash your hands you have to regularly use a hand sanitizer
  - Making use of the available hand sanitizer before entering a building
- Wearing a facemask when in contact with people in public spaces or buildings
  - You have to wear a facemask in each situation where a close contact is possible
  - You have to wear a facemask in indoor premises except when you are alone in a room
  - Informing people approaching you that they should also wear a mask in contact with you.
  - Disposable facemasks are only effective for a limited time. Replace your facemask at least each 4 hours and don't re-use it. Re-usable fabric facemasks need to be washed after maximum 4 hour of use.
  - We advise you to wear a facemask of the N95 or ffp2 quality, as those facemasks gives the best protection.
- You are not allowed to visit events
  - An event is each organised or non-organised gathering of more than 25 persons indoor or outdoor.
- You are only allowed to visit the outdoor seating areas of bars and restaurants.

- You have to inform the staff of the bar/restaurant that you are under the monitoring protocol so that they are aware of your status and can take this into account.
- In restaurants you are allowed to take off your facemask while eating and drinking
- You are only allowed to work as long as you can adhere to the protocol during your work
  - All rules given above also are valid during work
  - You have to inform your employer on your status and agree with your employer on how you will conduct your work during the monitoring period.
  - Indoor work is only allowed if you can work alone in a building, or alone in a room and can make use of separate sanitary facilities.
  - Meetings with other persons are only allowed to be held in outdoor areas

Outdoor work should be done with separation from other workers. If this is not fully possible than everyone present should wear facemasks

I read and understood the monitoring protocol and will adhere to this protocol during the first 5 days of my stay until I have received the test result of a second rapid antigen test on the 5th day after arrival.
